



SCANNER TECHNOLOGIES ANNOUNCES COURT RULING

MINNEAPOLIS, Mar 2, 2004 (BUSINESS WIRE) -- Elwin M. Beaty, President and CEO of Scanner Technologies Corporation (OTCBB:SCNI), announced today that the Company has received a ruling on its suit regarding excess charges by its former patent attorneys.

Scanner Technologies filed suit in August 2002, in Phoenix, Arizona, alleging among other things, that their previous legal counsel, retained to litigate patent infringement claims against one of their competitors, ICOS Vision Systems Corporation, had overcharged Scanner in its prosecution of the infringement suit. A trial was conducted in December 2003.

The court held that, "the number of hours billed by the Defendants was grossly excessive." In its ruling, the court reduced by 80% the outstanding balance due defendants. This amounts to a reduction of over \$320,000. Scanner has been carrying the full amount on its books as trade accounts payable and will reflect the reduction in trade accounts payable in its first quarter 2004 financials.

Scanner Technologies is a technology leader in inventing and developing high speed, high accuracy 3D inspection technologies and holds more than nine patents.
