Scanner Technologies Corporation (OTCBB:SCNI) today announced that it has entered into a Stipulation For Dismissal Of Certain Counts with ICOS Vision Systems Corporation N.V. relating to a law suit brought by ICOS against Scanner in July 2005, in the United States District Court, Southern District of New York. The parties have agreed to narrow the issues in dispute. Scanner does not believe that this Stipulation will have a material adverse effect on its business or prospects.

Scanner Technologies is still awaiting a court decision on its claims for patent infringement against ICOS Vision Systems of U.S. Patents 6,064,756 and 6,064,757, which was tried in the U.S. Southern District of New York in March 2005.
